Silke has already deployed its FleetNet™ Digital radio network to a large portion of the Sacramento area, and offers seamless coverage via partners for the remainder. Work is underway to boost network capacity and coverage in anticipation of increasing demand. “We always build to stay ahead of demand, which is one reason why our customers like the network. Lately, and particularly in the California market, we’ve had to amp up our efforts. It’s a very nice challenge to be encountering such rapid growth,” says Silke. The high-quality, push-to-talk digital radio network is one category of Silke’s offerings that has defined its rapid growth in Oregon and Washington.

Silke was founded in 1964 to serve Oregon’s Willamette Valley. In 2009 the company began a second phase of growth and expanded across Oregon and into Washington through a combination of acquisitions and new openings. In 2013 the company entered California when it purchased another wireless communications solutions provider in the Santa Cruz/Salinas area. Sacramento is Silke’s second California location.

Historically the company provided two-way radio-based communications equipment and built and operated a proprietary digital network, FleetNet™.
